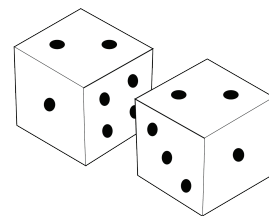


4-H GAME DESIGN CHALLENGE

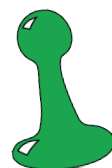
